Feathers help birds fly, and each kind of bird has its own special feather pattern!

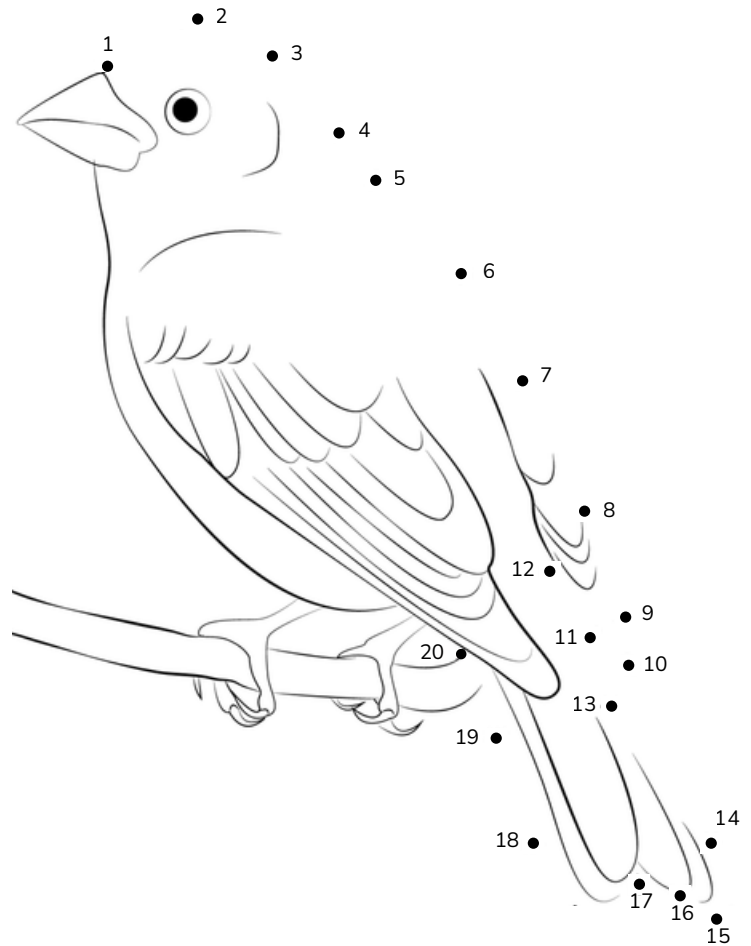
3 Find the Hidden Letters
